2023 Membership Renewal

Membership renewal will take place through the website hosted via MemberClicks. The system will automatically send your invoice along with two renewal notifications and three grace-period notifications.

By what date should I renew my membership?

In order to ensure that you maintain your membership benefits, you should renew by **December 31, 2022**. If you have a *JNEN* subscription, we encourage you to renew prior to this date as to avoid any disruptions in your subscription. Please note: If you do not renew before December 31, 2022, your *JNEN* subscription will be cancelled in accordance with the Bylaws of AANP.

What if I forget to renew before December 31?

There is a grace period from January 1, 2023 through March 31, 2023. If you renew during the grace period, your *JNEN* subscription will be reactivated.

Why should I renew my membership?

There are real benefits of membership including:

- Free online subscription to the *Journal of Neuropathology and Experimental Neurology* for Active, Junior, and Associate members; and a reduced subscription cost for Senior Members - \$40.00 for online, \$65.00 for print
 - Waived page charges and a reduced open access rate
- Reduced registration at the annual meeting
- Access to and listing in the directory of neuropathologists (if desired)
- Ongoing AANP communication via e-mail and newsletters
- Involvement in AANP Committees (Active members and select Junior members)

How do I renew my membership?

The e-mail notifications, which will begin November 1, include directions on how to renew. You will be provided a link to renew online (<http://www.neuropath.org/renewal2023>), which should only take a few minutes.

How do I log-in?

Username: Each member's username is the email you used to register with AANP, and the one we use to communicate with you. You have received this email at the address we have on file, and it is your username in the format: emailname@host.edu

Password: If you have not previously logged in to your Member Profile, you will need to set-up a new password by clicking the "forgot password" link. Instructions for changing/resetting your password will be sent to your email address, and you can use this function at any time in the future.

What else do I need to know about renewal?

Whether renewing online or via a paper form/check, there will be several optional add-ons

- **Print JNEN Subscription for Active, Junior, and Associate members:** The print edition of the *JNEN* is \$50.00
- **JNEN Subscription for Senior Members:** The online edition of the *JNEN* is \$40.00, and the print edition of the *JNEN* is \$65.00
- **Donate:** You will be provided with an opportunity to donate to AANP's general fund or to specific funds

What if I do not renew before March 31, 2023?

If you are in arrears and do not renew before March 31, 2023, your membership will be terminated. If you wish to rejoin AANP, you will need to go through the application process. If you are up-to-date on dues, you will be placed in arrears and must become current on dues in order to reactivate your membership.

What if I am a Senior member?

As a senior member you are not required to pay membership dues, however, we would like to confirm that we have the correct contact information. Additionally, we would like to confirm whether or not you would like a subscription to the *Journal of Neuropathology & Experimental Neurology* at a reduced rate (online edition is \$40.00 and the print edition is \$65.00).
