

## **Senior Staff Neuropathologist**

As the university pathology department of Michigan State University College of Human Medicine (MSU-CHM), academic appointments will be commensurate with accomplishments in diagnostics, education, clinical investigation, national service, and publication. The mandate for neuropathology is to create higher levels of sophisticated clinical diagnostics, clinical research, basic science support, and education. Pathology houses the most comprehensive NGS and Cytogenomics testing service in Michigan staffed by 7 molecular pathologists and 4 LGG certified clinical scientists. This neuropathologist position is fortified by partnerships with clinicians and scientists of the Henry Ford Neuroscience Institute, ranked in the top 10% of neuroscience centers nationally and home to the Hermelin Brain Tumor Center providing unique access to the largest U.S. brain tumor biorepository with combined informatics database. Henry Ford is a major participant in the National Cancer Institute's Adult Brain Tumor Consortium, performing innovative phase 1 and 2 clinical trials.
