AANP Centennial Meeting

The AANP is looking forward to the 100th Annual Meeting, which will again be a hybrid meeting! The meeting is set to occur in Olympic Valley, CA at the Everline Resort and Spa, while the virtual live-stream portion will be hosted via the vendor *Blue Sky eLearn*.

The Centennial Meeting features a one-day *Special Course* focusing on "Reflecting Backward While Marching Forward", followed by two days of scientific sessions (platform and poster) in which members present original research, an evening *Diagnostic Slide Session*, and a half-day *Presidential Symposium* titled, "Our Local and Global Connections in Neuropathology."

This year the AANP is pleased to offer three ancillary meetings on Wednesday, June 5. Registrants for the 100th Annual Meeting are eligible to register and attend one meeting in person as the meetings occur concurrently. There is no additional fee to register for an ancillary meeting. Please note that two of the meetings have attendance caps due to room capacity. The meetings will NOT be live streamed; however, recordings of the audio and slides will be made available to all registered attendees following the 100th Annual Meeting and will be available through August 31, 2024.

AANP Fall 2023 Membership Survey

The <u>AANP Fall 2023 Membership Survey</u>, conducted between mid-October through late November of 2023, was completed by 118 AANP members. Responses drive AANP development of educational activities, including Annual Meeting content, and help document professional practice gaps and subsequent areas of education need, which is an ACCME requirement for accredited CE. The survey is <u>NOT</u> a test; instead, it is a tool to illuminate topics or areas for which education might be appropriate.

The primary focus of the survey is clinical assertion statements which are developed by the Education Committee and focused on identified areas which change from year to year. This year the survey focused on the following topic areas:

- Toxic/Metabolic
- Methods in Education Residents and Medical Students
- DNA Methylation
- Cognition/Memory Formation and Related Disorders
- New or Provisional CNS5 WHO Entities
- Digital Pathology
- Artificial Intelligence


